"Great. Now you can invite up to 5 people to view your itinerary - all you need to do is enter their email addresses in the fields provided. Enter a password that they can use - preferably a different one to yours so that they can't modify your itinerary. Click on the 'send details' button on the right and your chosen people will be sent an email which will invite them to view your itinerary."

"That's great Bill, I shall send some off immediately."

"Good idea Ben. In the mean time I'm going off to explain to my wonderful assistant Barbie how she can enter and modify itineraries for me."

Time Traveler Tip #1

Time Travel provides a 'note' field that gets associated with the departure appointment in your Palm Date Book. You can use that note field for any purpose including seat number, meal arrangements etc.

Some customers also record both their flight number and other details in their flight number field. Now if you tap on the date in the main screen of Time Travel the details you have entered in the 'Ship/Flight #' field will be instantly displayed.

Time Traveler Tip #2

All three of Time Traveler's applications, Time Place, Time Travel and Time Book, now have help menus. Simply tap on the Menu icon which is located at the bottom of the screen on the left of the grafitti area and then tap on 'Help' at the top of the screen and you will be presented with a choice of 'Help' topics. Sometimes an 'i' icon will appear in the top right corner of a dialog box and you can obtain specific information from tapping on this.

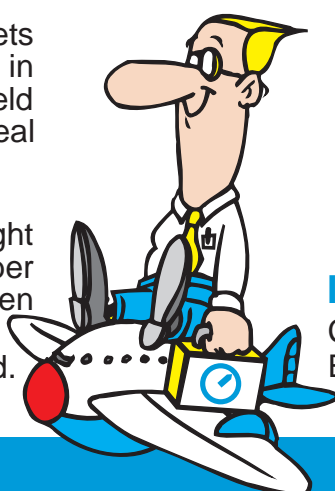
