Bill and Ben the Time Traveling Men

Bill and Ben the Time Traveling men. London one day, New York the next. Conference calls in Dallas and Denver, public relations in Miami and Milan.

"Barbie," says Bill, "the other day you asked me how you could enter and modify itineraries for me using MyTime Traveler. I have a minute, would you like me to show you now?"

"Yes please Bill," replies Barbie, "it will certainly make life much easier."

"Well it will save me a lot of time if you are able to enter all these details for me and that will be most appreciated!"

"Great, let's get started."

"Let's. First we go to www.mytimetraveler.com as I showed you last time," starts Bill. "Now login as 'New User' Barbie and use your own password. Barbie you will have to have a longer password than 'Ken' because both your name and password need to be longer than five letters for security reasons."

Barbie thinks of and types in a longer password.

"That's great," continues Bill, "Now in the 'New Itinerary for Others' section, enter my username and then my password twice. Click on the 'Create' button and you will be presented with an empty itinerary screen for me. You see at the top it says 'Itinerary for billie' and to start adding my itinerary information you simply click on your choice of 'Add' buttons which are located directly underneath this line. You will be taken to another screen where you add that appropriate information. Once you have done this you click on the 'Save' button which is on the top or bottom right hand side of the screen."

"Once you have entered all the information you can click on the 'Notify Traveler' button on the left of the screen and fill out the boxes in the following screen. Now click on the 'Notify Traveler' button on the right and the new itinerary will be emailed to me. You will be taken back to the itinerary screen and it will tell you at the top that I have been notified. Now if you have finished you simply click on the 'Logout' button on the left of the screen."

"That's great Bill," says Barbie.

"Yes it is Barbie. Now to modify my itineraries all you need to do is enter your name and password in the 'Existing Users' section and the succeeding screen will ask you if you would like to modify an itinerary you have already created and these itineraries will be listed. Just click on the itinerary you wish to modify and you will be taken straight into this itinerary. Change the information you need to and then click on

the 'Notify Traveler' once again. When I next sync my Palm Pilot I will go into 'Travel Sync' and it will inform me of the latest changes and all my information will be automatically updated."

Bill leaves Barbie to ponder the wonders of MyTimeTraveler and sits back, comfortable in the thought that there will be one less thing to do when he has to travel.

Time Traveler Tip #1

To translate airport codes into cities launch Time Place, enter the 'list screen' (fourth icon, bottom right) and then enter your airport code. Tap on the entry and you will see its details. The 'Based On' field reflects the city that the airport code is associated with.

Time Traveler Tip #2

To successfully Hotsync with Outlook while traveling you need to ensure that your device's time zone and Outlook's time zone are the same - before you Hotsync. You also need to change the preferences of Time Book by configuring it to capture all appointments automatically. This will then cause Time Book to move all of your future date book appointments to a time zone you travel to i.e. the same happens with Outlook when you change time zones.
